

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Population Change, Percent by Tract, US Census 2010 - 2020








Race Demographics





















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Property Crimes, Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, MO State Highway Patrol 2017




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Veterans, Percent of Total Population by Tract, ACS 2016-20




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Population Migrated from Outside of the County, State, or Country, Percent of Total Population by Tract, ACS 2016-20
















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Unemployment, Rate by County, BLS 2022 - September



Child Care Costs

For the 2018 Market Rate Survey, Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, which is responsible for licensing childcare facilities, provided a list of all licensed facilities. Surveys were made available online to 2,957 providers. Providers were notified by multiple email messages. A total of 1,343 surveys were completed and providers were offered a modest incentive to enhance participation.

Surveys returned with no rate for a given category of care had no influence on calculating rate information for that type of care. Because of this, the total number of surveys for each type of care and classification varies depending on the number of providers that reported a rate for that type of care.

Caution should be used in interpreting results where there are few responses in a given geographical area or for a certain type of care. This is especially true with respect to Group Homes. Also, keep in mind that voluntary participation introduces the potential for self-selection bias. With respect to this particular survey, providers charging more than DSS rates may have a perceived incentive to return the survey in the hope of influencing state paid rates. Providers charging below or close to the DSS rates may be more satisfied and, therefore, have less incentive to respond. In addition, only licensed providers were surveyed. It is uncertain how the inclusion of unlicensed providers may have affected the results.










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Workers Traveling to Work by Car Alone, Percent by Tract, ACS 2016-20












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Population with No High School Diploma (Age 18+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2016-20









Child Care Costs

For the 2018 Market Rate Survey, Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, which is responsible for licensing childcare facilities, provided a list of all licensed facilities. Surveys were made available online to 2,957 providers. Providers were notified by multiple email messages. A total of 1,343 surveys were completed and providers were offered a modest incentive to enhance participation.

Surveys returned with no rate for a given category of care had no influence on calculating rate information for that type of care. Because of this, the total number of surveys for each type of care and classification varies depending on the number of providers that reported a rate for that type of care.

Caution should be used in interpreting results where there are few responses in a given geographical area or for a certain type of care. This is especially true with respect to Group Homes. Also, keep in mind that voluntary participation introduces the potential for self-selection bias. With respect to this particular survey, providers charging more than DSS rates may have a perceived incentive to return the survey in the hope of influencing state paid rates. Providers charging below or close to the DSS rates may be more satisfied and, therefore, have less incentive to respond. In addition, only licensed providers were surveyed. It is uncertain how the inclusion of unlicensed providers may have affected the results.










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Overcrowded Housing (Over 1 Person/Room), Percent by Tract, ACS 2016-20














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Housing Units Lacking Complete Plumbing Facilities, Percent by Tract, ACS 2016-20



Hours per Week at Minimum Wage Needed to Afford Housing, 1-Bedroom (at FMR) by County, NLIHC 2021





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Hourly Wage Needed to Afford Housing, 1-Bedroom (at FMR) by County, NLIHC 2021











Severely Cost Burdened Households (Housing Costs Exceed 50% of Household Income), Percent by Tract, ACS 2016-20







Number of Households earning 30% or 50% of Median Gross Income










